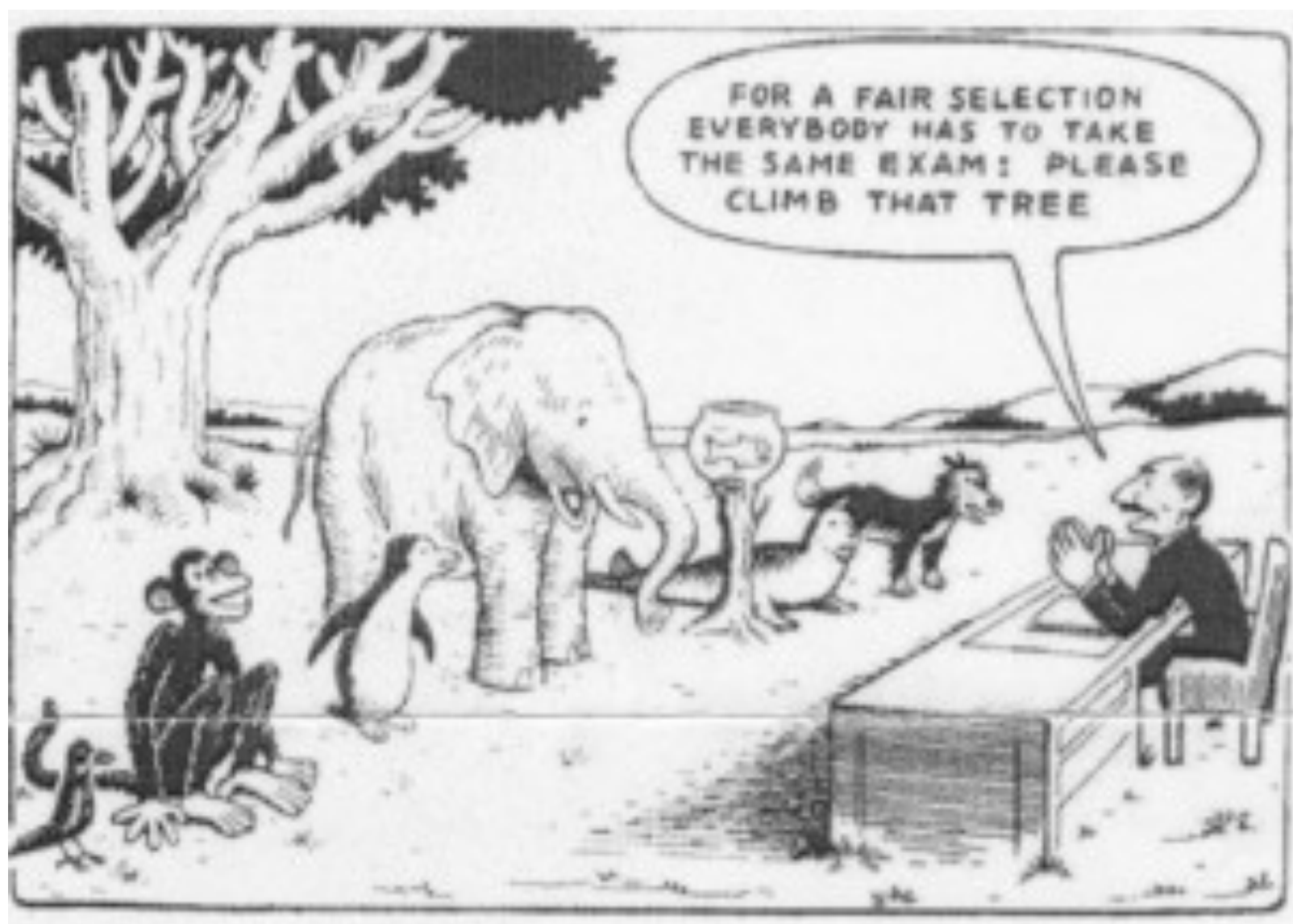


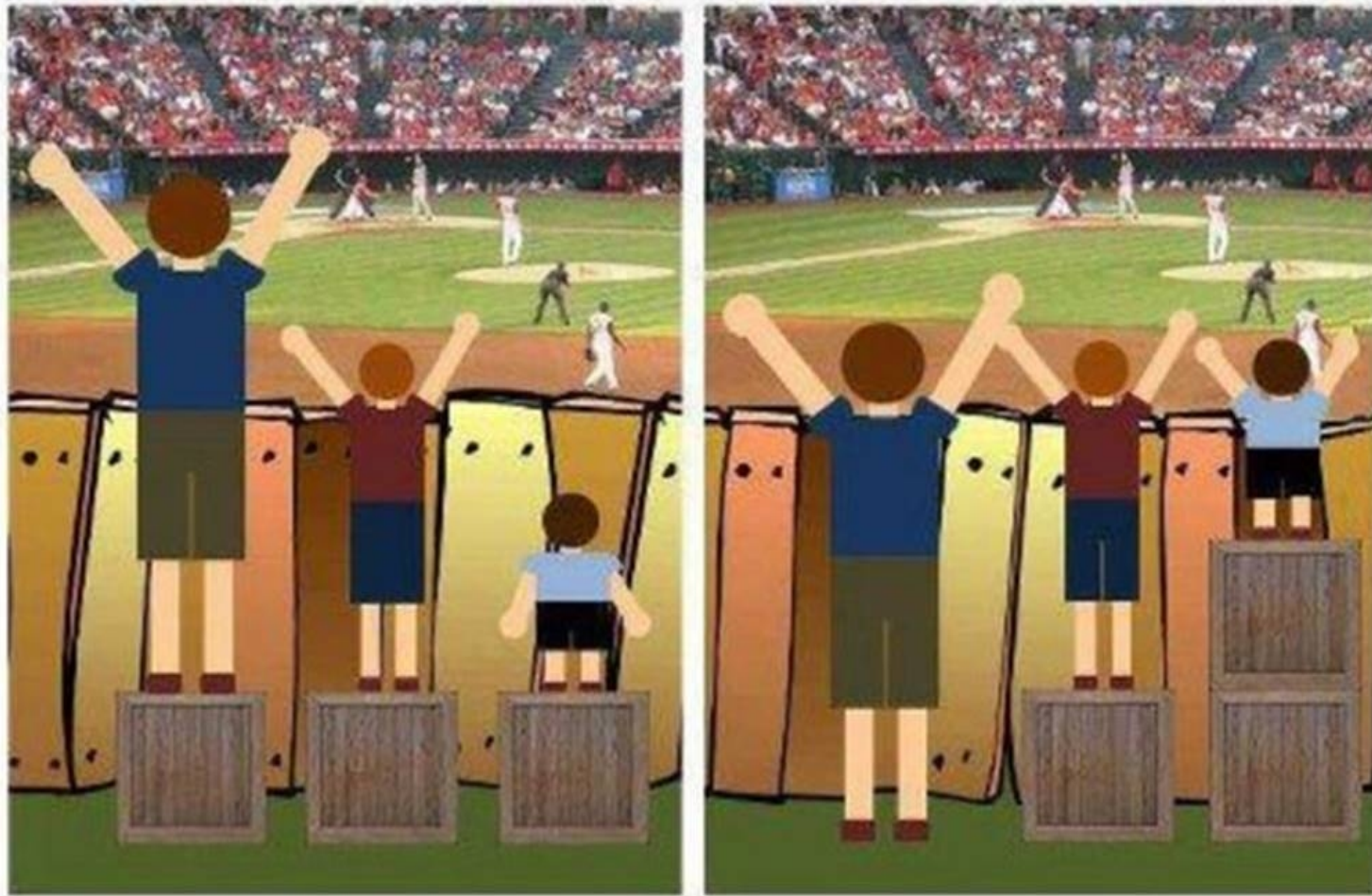
The Rainbow Report
